The most important decision on earth is to become right with God and His Son, Jesus Christ. Salvation, as presented by the Bible, means being forgiven of sins, entering into fellowship with Almighty God, and receiving eternal life. The saved are blessed with abundant living now and a reward in heaven later. The highest goal of every person on earth should

be to receive and live in God's salvation. The Bible says, "For what will a man be profited, if he gains the whole world, and forfeits his soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?" (Matthew 16:26). Our families, food, clothing, shelter, and education are of great value; but the salvation of the soul is the most valuable blessing that we can ever receive.

Once again, we urge you to read this book carefully. Study the "Guide to Eternal Life" found on the pages following the New Testament. When you understand how to become a Christian, make arrangements to become one immediately.
